

## Applying to Health Programs at BCIT

Acceptance to the above health programs is very competitive. Submitting a complete application not only means that a decision can be made on your application earlier, it may also improve your chances of acceptance. If you are applying on the web, make sure to follow up with all of your supporting documents as soon as possible after application. Submit all your documents at one time where possible. We do not recommend that you submit documents one at a time. **If this is necessary, allow 4 – 6 weeks for processing each individual document.**

1. [Apply online](#) or complete an [Application for Admission form \[PDF\]](#) from the BCIT website.
2. Attach documentation to your application. For online applications, submit supporting documentation by mail, fax or in person. The application checklist below outlines the minimum documents required to process your application.

Please refer to the program website for specific entrance requirements for your program.

### Application Checklist

***Please make sure your name and student number (A00.....) appear on all the documents.***

- Academic entrance requirements
- Completed and signed Program Forms available from the program website
- Official post-secondary transcripts
- If you have not already met the entrance requirements and are currently taking courses, you must provide proof of registration and interim marks
- Resume (if required)
- Letter of Reference (if required)
- Letter of Intent (if required)
- International Credential Evaluation (if required)
