



BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the 30.0 credits of core business courses, students are required to complete an additional 24.0 credits of general education in order to earn the BBA. This requirement may be met with lower or upper-level university courses in the following subject areas:

- 3.0 credits English Literature or Composition
- 6.0 credits Social Science or Humanities
- 6.0 credits unspecified credits
- 3.0 credits Natural Science
- 6.0 credits of Arts or Science
