- 1) No purchase necessary. Contest runs until May 20, 2011. Register for BCIT Forensics' CSI Academy by 11:59 pm, Friday, May 20, 2011 to be automatically entered into the draw. Or mail your name, address and telephone number to BCIT Centre for Forensic and Security Technology Studies, CSI Academy – Early Registration Contest, 3700 Willingdon Avenue, Burnaby, BC V5G 3H2. One entry per envelope. Mailed entries must be post-marked by May 20, 2011.
- 2) One (1) prize will be awarded. This prize consists of an Amazon Kindle valued at \$139. Prize winners must meet all entrance requirements and are not guaranteed admission in the academy.
- 3) The chances of winning are dependent upon the total number of eligible entries received.
