MMRE Practice 02 Minimum Academic Performance in the Bachelor of Mining and Mineral Resource Engineering Degree Program

MMRE Practice 02 defines the minimum academic performance required to remain in the Bachelor of Engineering in Mining and Mineral Resource Engineering Degree Program (Degree Program):

- 1. For students to be considered in "good standing" their weighted average GPA for each individual term must be at least 60%.
- 2. A student is placed "on probation" if his/her weighted average GPA for the most recent term drops below 60%.
- 3. Students on probation return to "good standing" if their weighted average GPA for the subsequent term rises above 60%.
- 4. Students on probation are placed "on academic suspension" and obliged to sit out from the Degree Program for the next term in the event that their weighted average GPA for the current term is less than 60%.
- 5. After sitting out for one term while on "on academic suspension", the student can apply to be readmitted on probationary status.
- 6. Students "on probation" that have previously been "on academic suspension" will be obliged to leave the Degree Program in the event that their GPA for any subsequent term is less than 60% and will leave with no prospect of returning.

The weighted average GPA is computed in accordance with the BCIT Grading Procedure 5103-PR1.
