If you wish to take a face-to-face class instead of an online class, you may switch to COMM 2002. All COMM 2002 classes are face-to-face. COMM 2002 covers the same content as COMM 2202, but has an additional half hour per class of English language and communication development. COMM 2002 and COMM 2202 are equivalent, and they both meet the level 2 COMM requirement for BCIT programs. If you wish to transfer to COMM 2002, please call 604.434.1610 immediately. A transfer fee may apply.
