Graduating Awards

Program Awards

BCIT Program Awards are presented to Two-Year Diploma graduates who obtain the highest standing in the final year of their program. No application is necessary. To be eligible for a program award, a student must carry a 100% course load in their final year.

Institute Awards

The following awards recognize outstanding graduating students. Awards are automatic with no application necessary.

Advanced/Post Diploma Graduating Achievement Award

Presented to a student graduating from BCIT with an Advanced or Post Diploma. The recipient must have an excellent academic record and have contributed in a positive way to the life of the Institute or the community at large.

Board of Governor's Award for Leadership

This award is presented to a full-time Technology or Trade graduating student who has demonstrated outstanding leadership and service to the BCIT community, and who has achieved at least a 70% class standing. Consideration is also given to activities and leadership in the outside community.

Dean's Award

Presented to an outstanding student in each School: Business; Computing and Academic Studies; Construction and the Environment; Health Sciences; Manufacturing, Electronics and Industrial Processes; Transportation.

Governor General's Silver Medal

Presented to the top academic student in a 2year Technology Diploma graduating class. All February and June graduates are considered.

Graduating Achievement Award for Baccalaureate Degrees

Presented to a student graduating from a BCIT Bachelor's degree program. The recipient must have an excellent academic record and have contributed in a positive way to the life of the Institute or the community at large.

Lieutenant Governor's Award for Technologies

Presented to an outstanding full-time Technology graduate from a certificate or diploma program (program must be up to but not exceeding twenty months in total length). The recipient must have achieved an excellent academic record and have contributed in a positive way to the life of the Institute or the community at large.

Lieutenant Governor's Award for Trades

Presented to an outstanding full-time graduate from a Trades/Technical or apprentice program (program must be up to but not exceeding twenty months in total length). The recipient must have maintained an excellent record of accomplishment in his/her program and have contributed in a positive way to the life of the Institute or the community at large.

President's Award

Presented to a full-time Technology or Trade graduating student with a first class standing who has a record of active participation in student activities, including ones that have brought recognition to the Institute, and has demonstrated strong teamwork skills.
