However, where the proposed programs are at the degree level or above, process and Ministry requirements are to obtain Board approval to NOIs.

Management answered questions relating to the anticipated intake of 20 to 25 students over the next three years which will be confirmed in the business case proposal.

Management answered questions relating to international student enrolment. Positive recovery of international student numbers is expected and full-time international enrolment remains strong.
