2.0 Consent Agenda

2.1 Adopt Agenda March 29, 2022

The agenda was amended to include the approval of the PacifiCan AAMTECH RIE Grant Contract as item #5.5, distributed on March 29, 2022, and the Fiscal Plan – FY2022/23, as item #7.0 (originally included in the Closed Board of Governors meeting, March 29, 2022).

As stated in the BCIT Board of Governors Bylaws (see #8(c) iv) 'the Institute budget and preliminary estimates are held in closed meetings', however, a request was made and approved (1 contrary) to present the Fiscal Plan – FY2022/23 (#7.2 of the Closed Board of Governors agenda March 29, 2022) in the Open Board of Governors meeting March 29, 2022 as item #7.0. Management confirmed that reports presented do not contain potentially confidential and sensitive information.

Responding to a question, management reported that within the BCIT community, there have been no reported tensions between groups relating to current political situations. The well being of students from all areas of global conflict is always taken into consideration.

5.0 Education Council

5.1 Education Council Chair Update

Received as previously circulated. The EdCo Chair answered questions regarding the timing of reviews for existing programs. Programs are reviewed regularly as a form of best practice and keeping current with industry demands.

5.2 Cancellation of Bachelor of Science in Food Technology and Operations Management

Distributed material: Decision Note, Report

Received and approved as previously circulated. The EdCo Chair reported that the term 'regularized faculty' are full-time faculty members, for whom employment will not be effected as a result of program cancellation.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT the Board of Governors approve the cancellation of the Bachelor of Science degree in Food Technology and Operations Management.

5.3 Proposal New Associate Certificate in Construction of Mass Timber Structures Distributed material: Decision Note, Report

Received and approved as previously circulated. The EdCo Chair reported that the final phase of the Student Housing project will offer an opportunity for students to learn in a 'living lab' environment.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT the Board approve the proposed Associate Certificate in Construction of Mass Timber Structures.

5.4 Proposal New Advanced Certificate in Building Energy Modelling and Performance Analysis

Distributed material: Decision Note, Report

Received and approved as previously circulated. The program will be offered in a hybrid (virtual and in-person) format. The program is similar to digital twinning which is a virtual representation of an object or system that spans its lifecycle, is updated from real-time data, and uses simulation, machine learning and reasoning to help decision-making.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT the Board of Governors approve the proposed Advanced Certificate in Building Energy Modelling and Performance Analysis.

5.5 PacifiCan AAMTEC RIE Grant Contract

Distributed material: Decision Note, Policy

Management highlighted key points from the decision note circulated on March 29, 2022. Management answered questions regarding a stacking limit of 90% with 10% from unique funding. Funding can be received from multiple federal agencies or funders for the same project.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT the Board of Governors approve the delegation of signing authority to Kathy Kinloch (the President) to sign the PacifiCan RIE Grant for \$1.935M in accordance with the Contracts - Policy #2501.

6.0 Student Governors

6.1 Student Association (SA) President's Update

The SA President introduced Liam Lauren, who has been elected as the SA President effective June 1, 2022.

The SA President reported that only one comment had been received from a student expressing concerns regarding the removal of COVID restrictions set by government.

6.2 Student Representative's Update

Distributed material: Information Note

Received as previously circulated. The Student Representative announced his successful re-election appointment from June 1, 2022 to May 31, 2023.

7.0 Fiscal Plan - FY2022/23

Distributed material: Decision Note, Presentation

Management reported that government has attended a previous Audit & Finance Committee meeting and acknowledges the current deficient, as a result of the pandemic, which is common across the sector.

Management reported that although there is a deficit, BCIT has a surplus of \$146M as of March 31, 2022. Per legislation, the Board of Governors cannot approve a deficit budget. However, the AEST has permitted board approval, across the sector, subject to receiving the AEST deficit approval letter expected in the fall 2022.

Management answered questions regarding the five-year annual surplus and deficit summary, Key points were highlighted from the FY2022/23 Budget Walk (Net Changes) showing the decrease in international tuition, salary increases, increase costs for the new Health Sciences Centre building, and other inflationary cost pressures.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT the Board of Governors approve the Fiscal Plan 2022/23, subject to final Ministry approval of the annual deficit budget. The 2% increase for tuition and mandatory student fees reflected within of the budget comply with the mandate of the Ministry of Advanced Education, and Skills Training (AEST) tuition limit policy.
