



Meet Your BBA Electives and Earn an Advanced Certificate in Sustainable Business

Now more than ever, businesses must consider not only the economic, but also the social and environmental value they create. By taking courses in sustainable business, you can complete your BBA elective requirements:

3.0 credits English Lit. or Composition (ENGL) 6.0 credits of Arts or Science (ASCI)
3.0 credits Natural Science (NSCI) 9.0 credits Unspecified credits (UNSP)
6.0 credits Social Science or Humanities (SSCI)

Option 1: If you are entering the BBA program with some of your elective requirements already completed, you may choose to take selected courses from the list below.

Option 2: If you are interested in earning an Advanced Certificate in Sustainable Business with your BBA and/or have all of your elective requirements to complete, then you would follow this process:

1. Apply for the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)
2. Apply for the Sustainable Business Advanced Certificate (concurrent with your BBA) by emailing admissions@bcit.ca for permission to co-register in two BCIT programs.
3. Take BSUS 5130, BSUS 5140, BSUS 5210, OPMT 5120, FMGT 5330, and a 6th course of your choice from the below list before, after, or while completing your 9 Required Core BBA courses.
4. Graduate with your BBA.
5. After completing all BBA graduation requirements, complete BSUS 5190: Sustainable Business Industry Project (the final course in the Sustainable Business Advanced Certificate).
6. Graduate with your Sustainable Business Advanced Certificate.
