Employers and Apprentices! - Apply today to receive funding for apprenticeship training costs including tuition and books. Eligible trades include:

- Electrician
- Instrument Technician
- Pipefitter
- Millwright
- Power Engineering
- Water treatment
- Marine Master
- More trades eligible for Northern BC residents

The LNG Canada Trades Training Fund can be accessed by employers on behalf of their apprentices. All approved funding will be made directly to BC's colleges and training providers, not to the employer or employee.

The LNG Canada Trades Training Fund is administered through the BC Construction Association on behalf of LNG Canada. In all cases, funding will be capped at \$1,300 per request per year as per the eligibility criteria.

The following eligibility criteria need to be met by applicants:

- Only small to medium size companies are eligible (50 or less employees)
- Employers must apply to the fund on behalf of their employee
- Applications must be received **one month prior** to the month the training starts. (e.g. for courses that begin in April, applications must be submitted by February 28)
- Eligible trades are now limited to the top in-demand Construction Trades

The Trades Training Fund has been established to:

- 1. Support employers, particularly small enterprises that employ, sponsor and train apprentices in the construction and related trades.
- 2. Support and increase apprenticeship training and completions.
- 3. Support workforce development and increase the number of skilled British Columbian journeypersons available to work in the trades.
