

**BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION  
General Education Requirement (February 2017)**

In addition to the 33.0 credits of core business courses, students are required to complete an additional 27.0 credits of general education in order to earn a BBA degree. This requirement may be met with lower or upper-level university courses in the following subject areas:
