This annual event brings together international researcher / lectures and students from HTW Berlin. This week can also be used to meet colleagues from HTW to discuss further cooperation and of course to visit the city.

Our students will leave their studies for a week to participate in the event. Lectures are meant to introduce students to a certain field of interest and allow them to work on a supervised project within those 4 days. Students present their results at the end of the week.

Next years' topic is: "Smart Communication Networks" which is explicitly meant to cover a very large range of IT-related topics and beyond, e.g. Smart Cities, communication protocols. Sensor but also social networks and social impacts can be tackled. Even the word "smart" could be questioned. All ideas are welcome which could be subsumed under this broad topic.

You are also warmly welcome to attend our annual *IT day* on June 10<sup>th.</sup>. It is a gathering of all IT related study programs and a number companies mostly from Berlin. There are talks, job offerings for students and a barbecue at the river Spree and a lot of space for talks and hopefully joy.
