BCIT Project Management Workshops LIVE STREAM Format FAQs

What are LIVE STREAM workshops?

Similar to the in-class workshops, LIVE STREAM workshops are delivered using a virtual platform where the instructor is online and leads the class providing the same coverage that students would have received attending in person. The instructor provides lectures, gives students exercises to reinforce the learning, and also answers questions, elaborates on topics covered, and facilities class discussions.

Students receive all course materials before class start and are able to follow along the course delivery with their materials. Student should register 3-5 days before class start to receive course materials.

How Are Students Provided Access to the LIVE STEAM Classroom?

Students are emailed the logon link before the course start along with instructions on how to access the classroom.

How Long is Each LIVE STREAM Workshop?

The workshops are the same start date and duration as provided on the course page, typically starting at 9:00 AM, with AM and PM breaks.

What Do Students Say About the LIVE STREAM format?

Many students really like the format. It allows them to take the training from the comfort of their home, office, and many other locations. It eliminates the need for travel and allows them to make better use of their availability.
