  - · i7 processor
  - · 16GB of RAM
  - · 512GB SSD
  - · Wireless standard 802.11n or Wireless 802.11ac
  - · 2x2 Wireless (will provide faster data transfer)
  - USB-3 or USB-C ports (for connecting devices)
  - · HDMI port (or HDMI dongle to connect to classroom screens for presentations)
  - · SD Card slot (or SD Card USB dongle for transferring media from camera memory cards)
  - · Chrome/Safari/Firefox installed web browser
  - · Power cord for recharging
  - · 2 hour or greater battery life. Classrooms may have limited access to power outlets.
  - Access to a printer

Touch screen option on your computer and stylus

### 4. Studio headphones with 3.5 mm jack:

- · Earbuds or gaming headsets are not acceptable.
- · Also purchase a 3.5 mm female to 1/4 inch male stereo headphone adapter jack.

#### 5. Smartphone:

- · Have multimedia capability (including social media, music, video, audio, camera).
- $\cdot\,$  Core phone functions like voice calls and text messaging.

### 6. Optional Items (recommended if your budget permits):

- Monitor to provide second screen (using extended screen mode in Windows). This is very useful when working with multiple documents.
- Tablet Touch screen device such as an Android tablet or iPad. Great for ebooks, as it is nice to have a separate device to read with. Tablets will not be sufficient as your only computing device for BCIT programs.
- Memory card Minimum 32GB 90MB/s SDHC UHS-I Class 10 Memory Card. Used to transfer photos and video from a camera to a computer.
- Audio mixer Minimum 2-channel compact stereo mixer. More control when producing audio projects with multiple inputs.
- · Portable external hard drive USB 3.0 Minimum 1TB. To backup assignments and files.
- · USB 3.0 flash drive Minimum 8GB. To store photos, videos, music, and office files.
