

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENTRY PROGRAM (ISEP)

The International Student Entry Program (ISEP) is an academic English language program that prepares students for success in full-time studies at BCIT, and helps them to meet the English requirements of a full-time BCIT Program.

To succeed at ISEP, students should have some previous experience studying English. The recommended minimum Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) level is 3.

HOW TO APPLY



STUDYING AT ISEP

ISEP has 6 levels. Each level takes one term (7 weeks) to complete. If a student starts at level 100, it will take them at least six terms to finish ISEP.

There are four classes in each level: Speaking, Listening, Reading, and Writing. Students are in class from 8:30am to 4:00pm, Monday to Thursday.

STUDY PERMIT

In Canada: students must provide proof of their valid status (visitor visa or work permit) and study permit application.

Outside Canada: students can study online for up to two terms (4 months) with proof that they applied for a study permit.
