OVER 400 AUTOMOTIVE INDUSTRY EMPLOYERS HAVE HIRED BCIT STUDENTS.

The BCIT ASTO program is a unique Red Seal pathway that prepares students to serve all aspects of the industry. In addition to repair and diagnostic training, apprentices are equipped with a fundamental understanding of automotive science and business operations.

WHAT CAN BCIT STUDENTS DO?

At the time of their co-op, students are prepared with technical training to:

- Perform general automotive maintenance
- Service wheels, brakes, suspension, steering systems, and drive shafts
- Understand automotive science concepts
- Engage in customer relations and business operations
- Perform engine repair, transmission, fuel delivery, electrical, and emission systems [level 3]

WHEN CAN BCIT STUDENTS WORK?

Students are required to complete four academic terms alternating between two 22-week co-op terms in an automotive repair facility. Typically students are available to work in the spring and fall.
