Those who are successful and pass this portfolio-based course will be listed on the SCBC website as passing BCIT's Green Shores Level 3: Professional Proficiency and meeting SCBC's requirements to be acknowledged as a Green Shores Approved Professional. This course will not gauge your experience and proficiency in your chosen profession. Rather, it will gauge your ability to apply the Green Shores credit and rating systems within the context of your profession.
