## survey results



Campus Development released a web-based survey on November 16 to December 11, 2015 that had 456 responses.

Across all questions, **117** comments related to cycling and walkways.

### *common themes*

78 comments

#### **On Walkways: Upgrade worn-out sidewalks.**

*“ Make it safe for pedestrians to walk anywhere, restrict vehicle to outside perimeter ”*

*“ Better connections between buildings ”*

*“ Improved pedestrian walk ways and plazas ”*

*“ Safer crosswalks and bike lanes ”*

*“ Better flow - clear direct paths from one end of campus to the other ”*

*“ More covered walkways between buildings ”*

*“ Uninterrupted rain shelter along cross-campus corridors ”*

*“ A more pedestrian friendly campus ”*

*“ Well planned sidewalks ”*

*“ Have more lighting on sidewalks and parking lots ”*
