DESCRIPTION

Dr. She and Dr. Chan Entrance Bursaries will be granted to students who demonstrate that they need financial assistance to be able to start their full-time post-secondary education.

The 2025-2026 BCIT Entrance Bursaries are for individuals who will begin a BCIT program between May 1, 2025 and April 30, 2026

VALUE

- The number of recipients will vary from year to year depending on the number of successful applications received, the programs applied for, and the funds available
- The bursary will cover the tuition and fees, and will be renewed each term, for the length of the program, for a maximum of 24 months from the program start date
- Bursary disbursements will be made in September and January of each year, or at the beginning of new term/level

SPECIFIC CRITERIA

- Must be a Grade 12 high school student who is graduating in the current year from Britannia Secondary, Templeton Secondary School, or Vancouver Technical Secondary School, all located in East Vancouver;
- Must need financial assistance to be able to start their post-secondary education, as demonstrated by the financial information provided on the application;
- Must have applied for admission to an eligible BCIT Trades Program or a BCIT Diploma Program in Engineering, Computing or Health Sciences as a full-time student as determined by BCIT (please see the list of eligible programs on the second page of this application).
- Must have a reference letter in support of the application from faculty or staff of the related High School.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a BCIT Entrance Bursary:

- You must be a citizen or permanent resident of Canada.
- You must have applied for admission to BCIT and been assigned a BCIT ID.
- You must commence full-time studies (60% or more of a 100% course load) between May 1, 2025 and April 30, 2026.
- You must remain registered as a full-time student during the academic period for which an award is given.
- You must maintain satisfactory academic standing during the academic period for which an award is given.
- You must successfully complete each term to be eligible for the next disbursement.

ENTRANCE AWARDS REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION & CHECKLIST

Every Entrance Bursaries application MUST include the following information:

- Entrance Awards Application Form (make sure you sign the application)
- CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT applicants must include an official high school transcript showing all final grade 11 marks and interim marks for grade 12 courses
- Confidential reference letter from faculty or staff of the related High School
