Subject: Change in payment options for tuition, rent, and other services

In an effort to be more fiscally responsible, BCIT stopped accepting direct credit card payments for tuition, rent, and other related services in May 2013. To compensate, other payment options were expanded at that time. These included greater access to online banking (bill payment service) and credit card payments through a third-party service known as Plastiq.

Following a formal review and based on student feedback, BCIT has terminated our agreement with Plastiq, and, as of May 2, 2015, will no longer be providing support to students who choose to use Plastiq as a third party payment service provider in order to pay for tuition, rent, and other services.

As BCIT does not accept credit card payments for tuition or rent, either directly or through third party service providers, use of any credit card service provider (including Plastiq) will not be honored by BCIT and will result in your registration being cancelled. Please note that BCIT will not be responsible for any fees incurred for such payments or returns.
