

Instructions for Wire Payments to Bank of Nova Scotia to BCIT **from Remitters Worldwide (outside of USA)**

Instructions	To send a wire payment from anywhere in the world (excluding USA), the remitter should provide the following information to their financial institution.
Required Information	<p>Pay By <u>SWIFT MT103</u> to Bank of Nova Scotia.</p> <p>Swift code: NOSCCATT</p> <p>Field 57 and 59 must be completed as shown:</p> <p>Field 57: //CC000203020 Bank of Nova Scotia P.O. Box 48700 595 Burrard Street Vancouver, BC CANADA V7X 1V6</p> <p>Field 59: (Beneficiary's account number and name) 03020 0112518 BCIT General</p>
Requested Information	<p>Request the bank to include in the payment details of the Wire :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The Student number and name or 2) Invoice number and, if needed, 3) Indication of the reason for the payment
