BSCH6100 – Clinical Instructional Skills	<p>Purpose: <i>In-depth preceptorship course for medical imaging.</i></p> <p>Overview: Full-length online course to introduce instructional techniques in the clinical setting. BC Preceptor Development Initiative: E-tips for practice education	<p>Purpose: <i>Preceptorship tools for all health professions in BC.</i></p> <p>Overview: Eight modules of practical clinical education tips based on experiences from general medical clinicians and faculty from all around British Columbia.</p> <p>Duration: 10 – 20 minutes per module</p> <p>Cost: Free</p>	<p>Online: practiceeducation.ca</p>
Preceptor Education Program for Health Professionals and Students	<p>Purpose: <i>Preceptorship tools for health professions in Canada.</i></p> <p>Overview: Online interprofessional self-directed modules, including downloadable resources, exercises, case scenarios, and references. Nine modules. Completion certificate available for each module.</p> <p>Duration: 30 – 45 minutes per module</p> <p>Cost: Free</p>	<p>Online: preceptor.ca</p>
Educator Pathway	<p>Purpose: <i>Workshop series to enhance healthcare preceptorship.</i></p> <p>Overview: Level 1 is an in-person seminar on foundations of preceptorship, available monthly to health authority employees. Second and third levels also available.</p> <p>Duration: Level 1 – 7.5 hours (1 workshop) Level 2 – 60 hours (8 workshops) Level 3 – 37.5 hours (5 workshops)</p> <p>Cost: Professional Development</p>	<p>In Person: PHSA Learning Hub; workshops held at various hospital locations</p>
