[Casper Test](#) – an online, open response situational judgement test (SJT)  
[Snapshot](#) – a one-way video interview

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All applicants to the BCIT Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program are required to successfully complete a **Casper Test and Snapshot video**.

Casper is an online test which assesses for non-cognitive skills and interpersonal characteristics that we believe are important for success in the BSN program. Snapshot is a video interview you record and submit. Casper and Snapshot were implemented to further enhance fairness and objectivity in the student selection process.

In order to use these assessment tools (Casper and Snapshot), you will be responsible for securing access to a computer with audio capabilities, a webcam, and a reliable internet connection for your selected test date. Casper can be taken practically anywhere that you can satisfy the aforementioned requirements. No exceptions will be provided for applicants unable to complete the Altus Suite due to technical or other factors.

You will be provided with a limited number of testing dates and times. Please note that these are the only testing dates available for your Casper test. There will be no additional tests scheduled. Ensure you register for Altus using the exact name you applied to BCIT.
