



ADDITIONAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FORM
CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK AND IMMUNIZATION REVIEW

Effective 1 January 2012, the British Columbia Criminal Records Review Act requires that students registered in a certificate, diploma, or degree program with a practicum component involving work with children and/or vulnerable adults must provide a criminal record check authorization to the Criminal Record Review program.

All students must submit to a criminal record check and be cleared by their local police authority prior to clinical placement. This is a requirement of the Health Authorities.

The British Columbia Health Authorities also require students to be fully immunized before they can be released to their clinical practicum.

I understand that should I be accepted to the program, I will be required to complete a clinical application that includes an immunization review form. The immunization form is part of the Practicum Application package.

I understand that failure to complete this immunization form or refusal to undergo a criminal records check will prevent me from completing the program.
