This form will be used to determine if BCIT will need to charge you an International Health Insurance fee for Guard.me temporary emergency medical coverage or if you are eligible to opt out.

If you choose to proceed with this option, then you must include proof of your private medical insurance coverage when submitting this form. Medical insurance policies that do not meet the minimum standards posted on our website will not be accepted for opt out purposes. **You are finished with this form.**

No – Since you do not have any medical insurance coverage for when you arrive in BC, you will be charged a **non-refundable** \$180 International Health Insurance fee and enrolled in Guard.me temporary emergency medical insurance during your [MSP coverage wait period](#). You should pay this fee along with your tuition fees. Failure to pay this fee could result in you being withdrawn from your program.
