Cohort and Response Rate

The **Entry Student Survey (ESS)** is an annual survey conducted by BCIT's Institutional Research and Planning Department that targets students who commence their program in the Fall term.

The survey provides an insight into the decision making process of incoming BCIT students, their experiences with BCIT services, as well as their demographic characteristics.

The cohort consists of all first term/full-time Technology, Trades, Technical Studies and Apprenticeship students, at all BCIT campuses, who commenced their program in the Fall term of 2022

How to Read this Report

This report presents information on the Institute-wide results and different program types. The four available sections are:

In most cases, when answer choices are not chronological or consecutive in nature, responses are sorted by the highest percentage to lowest. Multiple-selection questions, identified with a *(select all that apply)* note next to them, add up to more than 100%.

Rim weighting methodology was used to calculate a set of weights to demographically compensate for the answers collected, i.e. align the demographic profile of the respondents to that of the cohort. The 4 demographic segments used to calculate these weights, which were then used to calculate the percentages used throughout this report, are: School, Age Group, Gender and Program Type.

There is a 95% certainty (19 out of 20 times) of the accuracy in the survey results at the institute level with a +/- 2.5% margin of error.

Key Findings (Institute Level)

Demographics

- The large majority of students (82%) were domestic, 18% were international students.
- 8 in 10 of respondents (80%) were in Burnaby Campus.
- Over half (55%) of students had some post-secondary education prior to registering at BCIT.

• 56% reported that their main source of educational founding was "Personal savings", followed by "Support from family" (52%) and "Government student loans/grants" (25%), only 5% used BCIT awards/bursaries.

Deciding

- "Family/friend" was most selected by respondents (30%) when they were asked how they had first become aware of BCIT.
- When asked about their 3 main reasons for considering BCIT, 64% of respondents selected "Hands-on/practical training" followed by "Reputation" (57%), and "Program/course only offered at BCIT" (33%).
- "Establish a career" (71%), "Obtain a BCIT credential (i.e., certificate, diploma, or degree)" (53%), and " Personal interest/enrichment" (41%) were rated highest among the objectives for enrolling at BCIT.
- Only 38% of respondents applied to other schools besides BCIT.
- Top three post-secondary institutions students applied besides BCIT were University of British Columbia (35%), Simon Fraser University (33%), and Kwantlen Polytechnic University (22%).

Application/Admission Satisfaction


- Students showed high satisfaction with different aspects of BCIT Admission; "Clarity of entrance requirements" and "Ability to review the status of your application" had the highest satisfaction 85% and 80% respectively.
- Only 34% reported BCIT website was useful in assisting with their decision to enroll in BCIT.


Challenges

• Three main factors that could prevent students from continuing their education this term was: "Lack of financial support" (37%), "Mental health" (36%), and "Quality of instruction" (32%).


