The following report provides information relating to BCIT's graduates and their employment outcomes within one to two years after graduation.

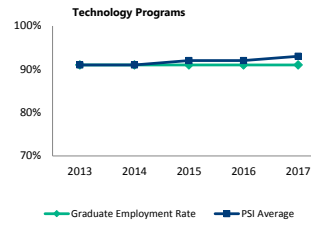

Graduate Employment Rate by Graduation Year

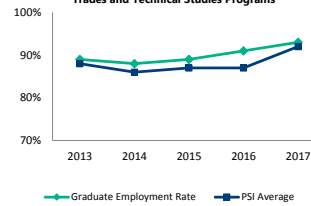

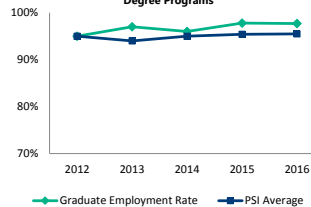

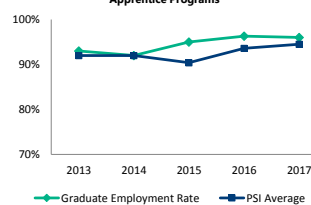
