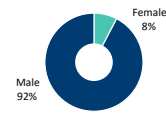

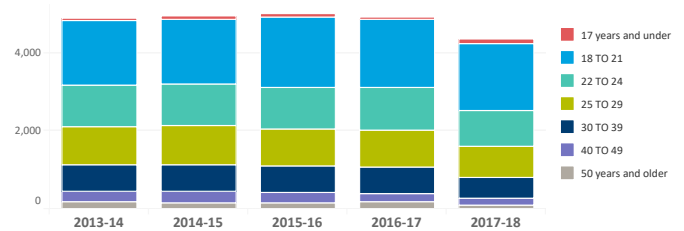

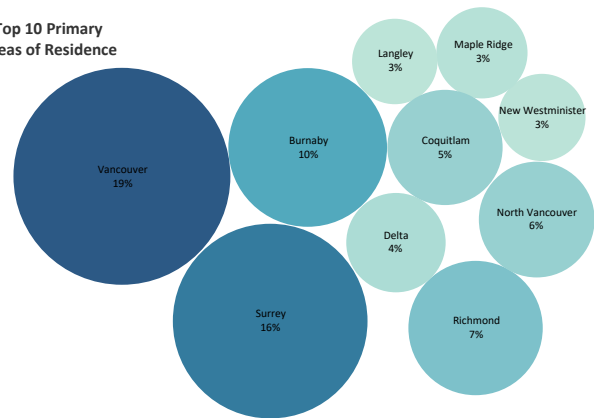

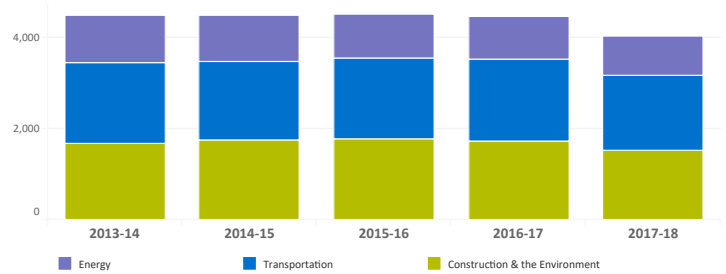

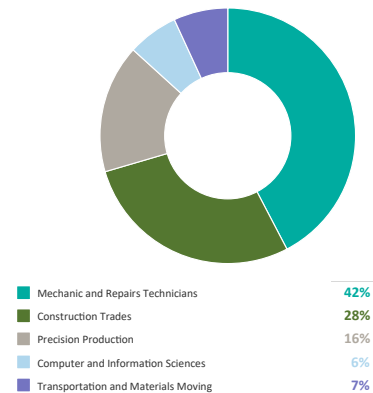

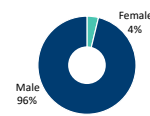

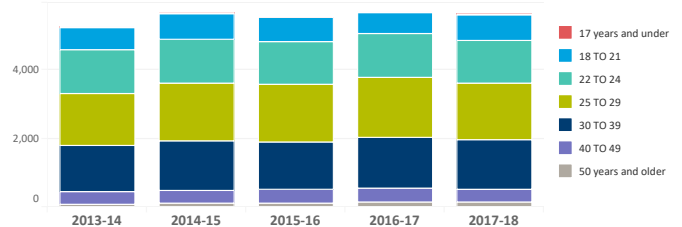

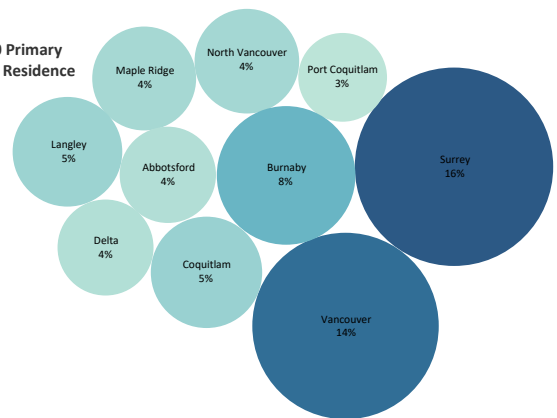
Gender Breakdown



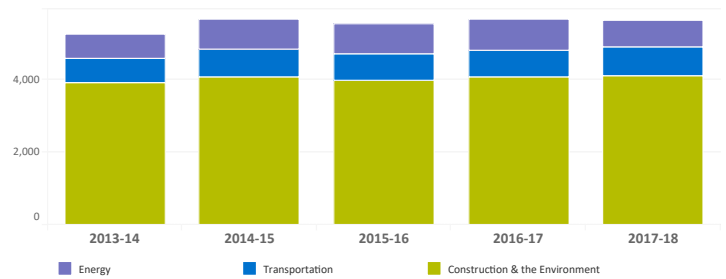

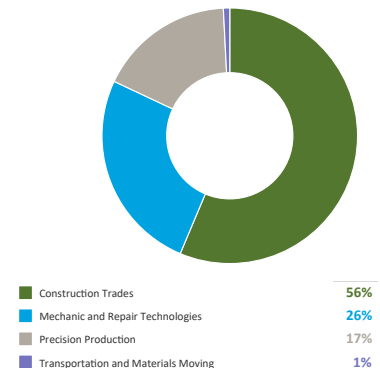
Top 10 Primary Areas of Residence
