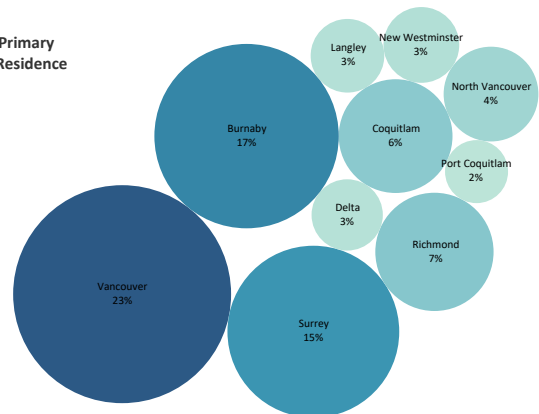

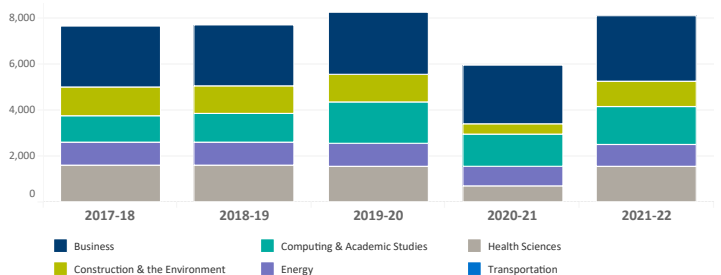
### Five Year Historical Trends



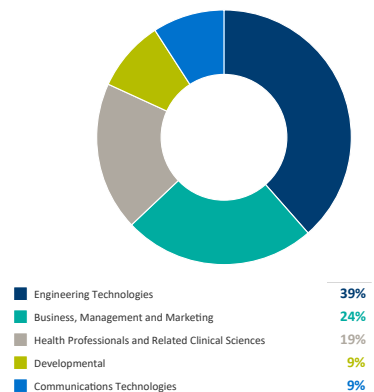
### Top 10 Primary Areas of Residence

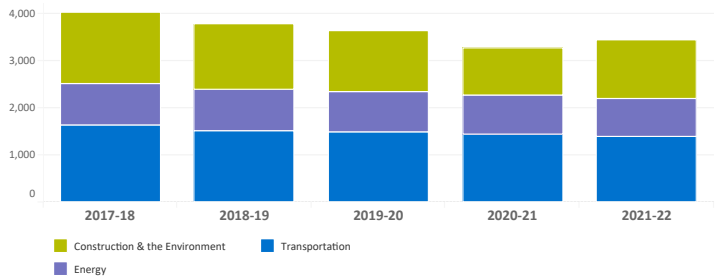

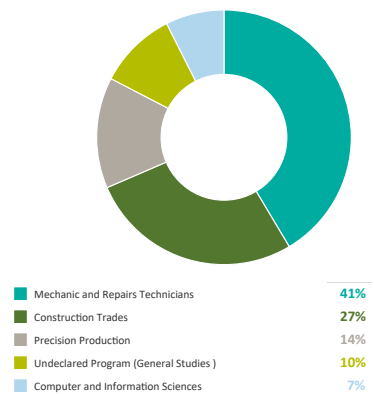
### Five Year Historical Trends

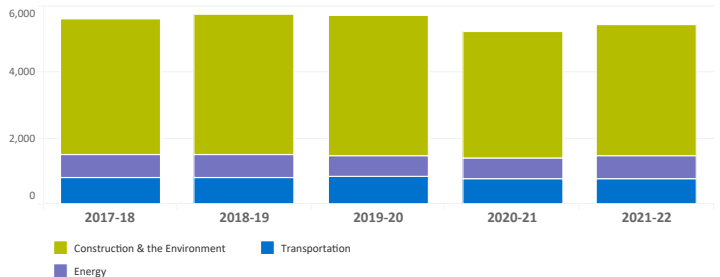

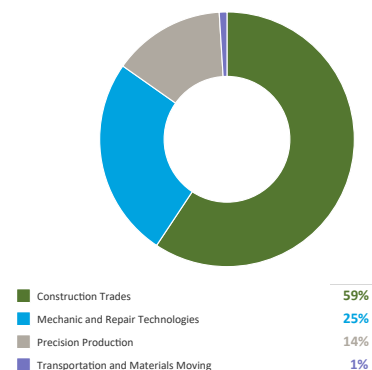
### Five Year Historical Trends

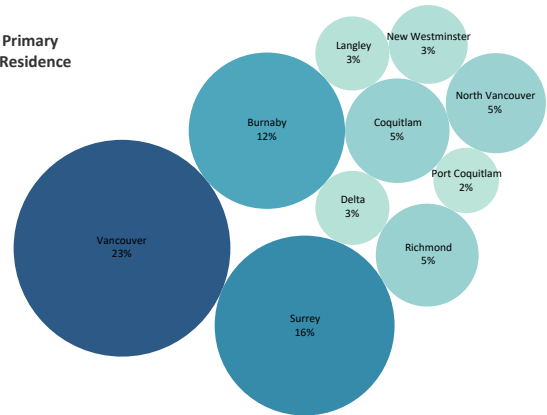

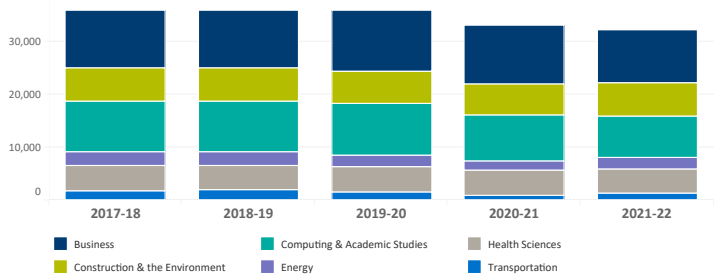
