PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY **RESPONSE RATE** The BCIT 2024 Student Check-in Survey is an annual survey conducted by The survey targeted Full-time and Flexible Learning students registered in the BCIT's Institutional Research and Planning Office. Winter 2024 term, 22.094 were successfully sent a survey invitation through the email list, and of those students 3,689 participated in the survey; yielding an overall The purpose of this survey is to reach out to current students and learn more response rate of 17% (response rates will vary by question). about their needs, challenges, concerns and future considerations. The 5 available sections are: Institue results **Full-time Technology results Apprenticeship results Trades & Technical Studies results** Flexible Learning results Rim weighting methodology was used to calculate a set of weights to demographically compensate for the answers collected, i.e. align the demographic profile of the respondents to that of the cohort. The results are weighted by: Age Group, Gender, Degree Type and Residency. There is a 95% certainty (19 out of 20 times) of the accuracy in the survey results at the institute level with a +/-1% margin of error. Multiple selection (checklist) questions add up to more than 100%.

Throughout the report, "-" and "x" are used when counts are "0" (zero) and <=5, respectively, to avoid the risks of disclosing the personally identifiable information.

- The vast majority of respondents (86%) were domestic students located in Canada, while international students located in Canada made up 13%.
- Six in ten (61%) were returning students with 39% being new students.
- Ten percent (10%) of respondents identified themselves as a person with a disability.
- Over one third of respondents (37%) identified themselves as members of a visible minority.
- Fifty percent (50%) of students reported their main mode of learning as "100% in-person learning", followed by "blended" (25%), and "100% online learning" (24%).
- Eighty five percent (85%) of students expressed satisfaction with the education they received during the Winter 2024 term.
- Forty seven percent (47%) of students indicated a high likelihood of recommending BCIT to family, friends, and/or co-workers (promoters or strong advocates), while 17% reported a low likelihood (detractors or non-advocates for BCIT), resulting in a net promoter score (NPS) of +30. Apprentice students had the highest NPS score (+40).
- Factors that could prevent students from continuing their education in Winter 2024 were: "lack of financial support" (42%), "hard to fit classes with job schedule" (38%), and "course load" (37%).
- When asked about how easy or challenging students found their education at BCIT, 54% responded that it was challenging.


• Results suggest there continues to be an awareness and usage gap abount BCIT student services. "Learning Hub" and "Bookstore" had the highest awareness and usage among BCIT student services. Overall students are fairly satisfied with BCIT student services that they have used, except for "parking" which had lower satisfaction (31%).


- In terms of the awareness and usage of BCIT Student Association services: "BCITSA Career Services" had the most awareness and usage, while "BCITSA Childcare Centre" had the least awareness and usage. Of those who used BCITSA Childcare Services, 100% reported satisfaction.
- Regarding diversity and inclusion, the respondents agreed that BCIT is a diverse and inclusive environment. While there was strong agreement with "At BCIT I am treated fairly and with respect" (80%), agreement was lower for "I am aware of where to report harassment at BCIT" (46%).
- Approximately half of Full-time students indicated their plans for next term remained unchanged (domestic 53%; international 52%).
- Forty five percent (45%) of domestic Flexible Learning students and 51% of international Flexible Learning students indicated no change to their plans for next term.
- Twenty five percent (25%) of international Full-time students, and 15% of international Flexible Learning students responded they will have completed their program by Fall 2024.
- Twenty five percent (25%) of domestic Full-time students, and 16% of domestic Flexible Learning students responded they will have completed their program by Fall 2024.








Overall, how easy or challenging do you find your education/training at BCIT this term?







How likely is it that any of the following factors could delay or prevent you from completing your education/training at BCIT this term?




