### Application Process

To complete your application:

1. Submit the following documents by email to [LearningCommons@bcit.ca](mailto:LearningCommons@bcit.ca) :
  - Your resume
  - A completed [Peer Tutor Application Form](#)
  - A pdf of your BCIT transcript (**unofficial transcripts accepted** and available at [my.bcit.ca](http://my.bcit.ca))
2. After downloading the [Instructor Referral Form](#), fill out the top section. Then, forward it to two instructors that have previously agreed to be your references.
3. Instructors should email the completed form directly to [learningcommons@bcit.ca](mailto:learningcommons@bcit.ca)

**Note: The forms are compatible with PCs. With Macs, they are compatible ONLY when using MS Word for Mac.**
