The Centre's goal is to help students develop the capacity to plan, organize, write, and revise various types of assignments, and to assist students in areas such as citation use and EAL (English as an Additional Language). We do not edit or proofread but ask good questions and provide feedback. Training is provided to support your development as a peer tutor.

Qualifications

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong writing skills
- Initiative and ability to work independently
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Two instructor references (one of which is from a communication instructor)

The ideal candidate will collaborate well with their peers, have earned a high level of achievement in a communication or writing course, and be capable of assisting peers with organization, grammar and punctuation.

- Guide students by assessing their writing needs, developing a plan for improving their work and encouraging good writing practices
- Assist in promoting the Centre's services as needed
- Complete paperwork accurately and on time
- Successfully complete paid writing tutor training
