Instructions for accessing BCIT peer tutoring online

Peer tutoring is available on the BCIT Learning Hub. You will use the Virtual Classrooms (also called Bongo) feature to connect with a peer tutoring session online. All tutorials are prescheduled drop-in sessions led by a BCIT tutor. Follow the instructions below to access your desired session.

How to access peer tutoring

- 1. Use the schedule to choose which session you wish to join. Sessions are listed by subject
- 2. Log into the Learning Hub
- 3. On your Learning Hub home page, select MY COURSES > ALL to locate a course called "BCIT Peer Tutoring"

How to enter a tutoring session

- 1. When your meeting time comes, enter the BCIT Peer Tutoring course on Learning Hub.
- 2. On the landing page for the course, locate CALENDAR on the right side of the screen
- 3. Ensure you have the correct day chosen in the CALENDAR function
- 4. Open the UPCOMING EVENTS list directly below the calendar date. You will see a list of scheduled sessions
- 5. Click on your desired session. This will open a description page with a link to the session
- 6. Click on the room link
- 7. You will be taken to an information page that gives you the option to JOIN the session
- 8. Click on the button that reads JOIN. The button must be blue for you to enter, and you cannot enter a room early.
- 9. Follow the prompts to activate your microphone and camera if desired

All tutoring is currently drop-in sessions. Unfortunately one-to-one tutoring is not available at this time.

What about writing tutoring?

You have 2 options to get help with your writing:

- 1. A live session with a BCIT Writing Tutor: follow the instructions above for Peer Tutoring and look for a virtual (Bongo) room called WRITING CENTRE
