Scientific Style and Format: The CSE Manual for Authors, Editors, and Publishers. 7<sup>th</sup> ed. was published by the Council of Science Editors (formerly named the Council of Biology Editors) in 2006. Scientific Style is a documentation style for writers in the various areas of scientific study. The *CSE Manual* describes two systems of documentation, the citation-sequence system and the name-year system. The system used will often depend on the field of study, or the preference of the instructor.
