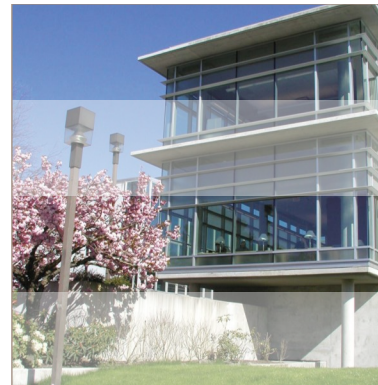

Why include article links in your courses?

The BCIT library website offers access to a huge collection of full-text journal articles online.

The advantages of incorporating a link to an article include:

- > You do not have to print copies
- > Students can access the article on or off campus
- > There is no copyright violation

Students can do their own searches for articles, but you can provide direct access to specific articles by copying the Permalink provided by EBSCOhost.

The Permalink icon will be located on the right side of the article in the Tools column.

Select it and the Permalink will appear above the article title.

Copy this URL . It will allow you to link directly from a web page to the article without searching through the database.

The link contains a reference to BCIT ***0-search.ebscohost.com.innopac.lib.bcit.ca***

This is how Ebsco knows to give access to a BCIT student or staff member accessing the article.

Note: If a student is off-campus they will need to login with their student number and network password to access the article.
