BIG INFO CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

February 2019

1. Contest runs February 20, 2019 during the BIG Info event from 4:30–7:30 p.m. No purchase necessary.
2. There are three ways to be entered to win the \$1000 tuition credit.
 - a. Any BIG Info attendee who visits our interactive booth, watches the 360 video and tells us the hidden code, in-person.
 - b. Anyone who is on the BCIT BIG Info registration list and completes the post-event survey.
 - c. Anyone who enters the BCIT Big Info contest on Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter.
3. By participating in this contest, each entrant and winner agrees that BCIT may post their name on the BCIT social media channels.
4. Maximum three entries per person.
5. Entries with inappropriate content (as determined by social media team) will be disqualified immediately.
6. Up to three prizes consisting of \$1000 BCIT tuition vouchers (3 X \$1000) will be awarded. Expiry date to redeem the prize is March 15, 2019. The expiry date to use the tuition voucher is April 30, 2020. [DD1] [CC2]
7. A maximum of 1 prize per person will be awarded, managed by the social media team.
8. Open to individuals who are B.C. residents [CC3] [DD4]. This contest is not open to current BCIT employees.
9. A selection will be made from all eligible entries received each week and all decisions with respect to the selection process are final.
10. Other smaller prizes to be awarded for participation throughout BIG Info event [TBC].

Before being declared a winner, the selected entrant will be required to sign a copy of these rules and regulations as the declaration and release form: A) Confirming compliance with contest rules and acceptance of prizes as offered; B) Acknowledging the non-responsibility of BCIT and the prize suppliers and their agents in respect to injuries, accident, loss or misfortune relating to the prize; C) Acknowledging BCIT and their agents' right to publish and broadcast the winner's picture and name.
