Position Summary:

The Intramural Sports Attendant is essential for creating a welcoming environment during intramural sports programs and events. Attendants are responsible for officiating, scorekeeping & ensuring participant safety during various leagues, resolving conflicts in a sport environment, and completing additional duties as needed. This position reports directly to the Sports Programs & Intramurals Coordinator.

Qualifications:

- Current BCIT student
- Minimum commitment of 3-5 hours per week for 2 consecutive terms
- Passion for recreation, active living and wellness
- Basic knowledge and understanding of the league sport atmosphere, culture and practices
- Professional, responsible, reliable and can exercise mature judgment
- Energetic, enthusiastic, and positive attitude
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent problem-solving and conflict resolution skills
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team; willingness to learn from and mentor others
- The following qualifications are not required but are considered an asset:
 - Valid Standard First Aid + CPR-C (or equivalent)
 - Previous experience in a recreation, sport (any) and/or customer service environment
 - Current or previous experience refereeing and/or coaching

Responsibilities:

- Greets participants, provides exemplary customer service, and ensures a welcoming and positive environment during intramural league programs
- Educates users on league rules, expectations, etiquette; ensures ongoing participant compliance with Intramural Guidelines
- Set up/take-down, scorekeep and manage league program flow
- Ensures safety of participants through ongoing monitoring of intramural league games
- Assists with resolving participant conflicts
- Assists with maintenance of scoresheets and league rosters
- Performs basic cleaning, organization and maintenance duties of Gymnasium and sport storage spaces
- Participates in professional development initiatives and goal setting
- Assists Recreation Staff with other duties and special projects as assigned
