Position Summary:

The Routesetter is responsible for duties related to routesetting at the BCIT Bouldering Studio. This includes, but is not limited to setting routes, cleaning and maintenance in the BCIT Bouldering Studio. This position is mentored and supervised by the Head Routesetter and the Sports Programs and Intramurals Coordinator.

Qualifications:

- Current BCIT student and commitment of 3-5 hours bi-weekly for 2 consecutive terms
- Passion for recreation, active living and wellness
- Minimum of 3 years indoor bouldering experience
- Demonstrated competence of basic climbing movement skills
- Minimum of 2 years commercial routesetting experience, bouldering preferred
- Ability to consistently forerun minimum V5
- Experience with safe work at heights, including ladder work
- Professional, responsible, reliable and can exercise mature judgment
- Energetic, enthusiastic, and positive attitude
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent problem-solving and conflict resolution skills
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team; willingness to learn from others
- Ability to give and receive feedback as needed
- The following qualifications are not required but are considered an asset:
 - Valid Standard First Aid + CPR-C (or equivalent)
 - Outdoor, competition, sport climbing, trad climbing and/or coaching experience
 - Ability to forerun V6+
 - Association of Canadian Mountain Guides Climbing Gym Instructor Certification

Responsibilities:

- Performs routine routesetting, including forerunning and tweaking, in compliance with safety policies and under the direction of the Head Routesetter and/or Sports Programs and Intramurals Coordinator
- Performs cleaning and maintenance duties related to routesetting
- Organizes and maintains equipment and storage areas
- Assists with route inspections of wall, bolts, holds, tools and other equipment
- Participates in professional development opportunities
- Performs additional duties as needed

Compensation: \$24.17 + \$1.25/hour in lieu of benefits + 6% vacation pay
