BCIT COVID-19 Information for Visitors

At BCIT, the safety of our students, faculty and staff, and the wider community is our first priority. As BCIT gradually re-opens its campuses, we have implemented the following safe work practices as per WorkSafeBC's requirements to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission:

- Physical distancing whenever possible
- Masks are required to be worn in common areas, such as hallways, stairwells, elevators, and areas where people circulate freely, but not in non-public areas such as classrooms and enclosed office spaces where physical distancing is possible;
- Providing the control measures needed, including specific work procedures and PPE
- Increased cleaning and disinfecting of campus areas

These safety practices are supported by area Safety Plans and/or Risk Assessments, which are completed by Schools and functional Departments. As an essential part of the BCIT Community, visitors are expected to know and follow BCIT's COVID-19 safety protocols while at BCIT.

EXPECTATIONS FOR VISITORS

Before Visiting:

- Complete daily self-screening by using the <u>BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool</u> and confirm with your BCIT Contact no symptoms of COVID-19 prior to attending BCIT
- Review the Safety Plan, Risk Assessment or other applicable safety information provided to you by your BCIT contact

While Visiting:

- Follow the safety measures outlined in the Safety Plan, Risk Assessment or other safety information for the area you are visiting, as applicable
- Stay 2 metres apart from others
- Wear a face mask at all times while indoors
- Follow posted safety signage
- Wash or sanitize hands frequently
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands
- Cough or sneeze into the bend of your elbow
- If you become ill, notify your BCIT Contact immediately
